02. **NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY (NEP) 2020**: The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 is a transformative initiative to usher India to prepare itself to meet the challenging demands of a 21st century knowledge society.

The National Curriculum Framework for School Education 2023 – (NCF-SE):

NCF-SE is one of the key components of NEP 2020, that enables and energises this transformation, to provide the highest quality education for all children, consistent with realising an equitable, inclusive, and plural society as envisaged by our Constitution.

This NCF-SE has divided the school curriculum into four Stages as per the recommendation of NEP 2020.

a) 5 year of Foundational stage:

Age : From 3 to 8 years.

Class : From Pre-School, LKG, UKG, Std.I & II.

Focus: Play and activity based learning method and development of language skills.

b) 3 years of preparatory stage:

Age : From 8 to 11 years

Class : From Std.III – V.

Focus: Develop Language and numeracy skills, play and activity based teaching method.

It also includes classroom interaction, reading, writing, speaking, physical education and Art etc.

c) 3 years of Middle stage:

Age : From 11 to 14 years

Class : From Std.VI to VIII

Focus: Critical learning of objectives, Experiential learning in Science, Mathematics, Arts, Social Science, Humanities, Life Skills etc.

d) 4 years of Secondary Stage:

Age : From 14 to 18 years

Class : Std.IX to XII.

Focus: Multidisciplinary education, Develop Critical thinking, Flexibility and Choice of subjects.

- NEP 2020 aims at 100% Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) in school education by 2030.
- No rigid separation between Science and Arts, Curricular and Extra Curricular activities, Vocational and Academic streams in school.
- Vocational Education to start from Std.VI with Internships.

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03. **ASSESSMENT AND EVALUATION PRACTICES OF THE BOARD FOR THE SESSION 2024-25:** The Board in accordance with National Education Policy, 2020 has taken multiple steps towards implementation of Competency Based Education in schools. The main emphasis of the Board is to create an educational ecosystem that would move away from rote memorization and towards learning that is focused on developing the creative, critical and systems thinking capacities of students to meet the challenges of the 21st century.

The changes for classes IX-XII year-end Board Examinations - 2025

Std IX & X : There is no Change in the Exam format for Std IX & X

- Competency Focused Questions in the form of MCQs/Case Based Questions, Source-based Integrated Questions or any other type = 50%
- Select response type questions (MCQ) = 20%
- Constructed response question (Short Answer / Long Answer Type Questions, as per existing pattern) = 30%

Std XI & XII : The Changes are as follows

- Competency Focused Questions in the form of MCQs/ Case Based Questions, Source-based Integrated Questions or any other type = 50%
- Select response type questions (MCQ) = 20%
- Constructed response questions (Short Answer Questions/Long Answer type Questions, as per existing pattern) = 30%

04. **NEW TEXTBOOKS FOR CLASSES III AND VI:** New Syllabi and Textbooks for Classes 3 and 6 are introduced as per the new pedagogical practices and areas of study aligned with NCF-SE 2023.

There is no change in the Curriculum and textbooks for other classes for the academic year 2024-25.

05. **SCHOOL TIMINGS:**

June,2024 onwards - 08:30 A.M. to 03:30 P.M.

Late comers and those who are not in proper uniform will be sent home after three(3) warnings. Students will not be permitted to leave the school premises in between the school hours and gate pass will be issued only in case of sickness or an emergency.

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06. **SCHOOL UNIFORM:** White uniform should be worn on Mondays / special occasions and Blue uniform from Tuesday to Saturday. All students must come in proper and neat uniform. Girls must use only black hair pins, gold ornaments are not allowed. Boys are not permitted to come in pencil cut, low waist pants and must have close crop hair cut or else necessary disciplinary action will be taken.

Please hand over Term-I Note Books to the respective Class Teachers for Jr.Kg. to Std.II. Text Books and Note Books for Term II upto Std.V can be retained at home and should submit them in Term II commencing from October,2024.
08. **ACADEMIC CALENDAR & YEAR PLAN 2024-25:**
- i) The Academic Calendar 2024-25 with the schedule for the Examinations, Events and holidays is uploaded on the School website.
 - ii) Year Plan 2024-25 of all subjects in the curriculum is uploaded on the school website www.jsikile.in for the guidance of the parents to review the syllabus completion.
09. **DISCIPLINE:** Discipline significantly impacts career shaping and helps build character, sincerity, self-control, perseverance, good behavior and values. Students should abide by the code of conduct at all times. Every member of the staff has a responsibility to maintain a high standard of discipline throughout the school. Corporal punishment is expressly prohibited in the school and student discipline practices are based on restorative principles focused on maintaining a safe and supportive learning environment.

Hygiene, sanitation, cleanliness, dedication, honesty, truthfulness, kindness, empathy respect for the environment, elders and all living things etc. are the values that our students must actively practice. Parents are also expected to support school in cultivating disciplined behavior in their wards.

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10. **NEW ADMISSIONS 2024-2025:** Admissions into **Kindergarten, Std.III to XII** are in progress for the **Academic Year 2024-2025**. **Application and prospectus** can be obtained at the Accounts Office.

All the new admissions should come in Uniform with the prescribed set of Text books and Note books. Please note that non-submission of Transfer Certificate, Birth Certificate on/before 30.06.2024 may warrant cancellation of admission.

The following Groups are offered in **Class XI and XII** and the classes for XI will commence from **1ST JULY,2024**. The students should submit their duly filled in Applications for admission and register the group that they are opting for in **Class XI**.

English Core and Multimedia are common for all the groups with Electives as follows:

Group 1	Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology.
Group 2	Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science / Hindi / Telugu
Group 3	Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Hindi / Telugu
Group 4	Mathematics, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy
Group 5	Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy, Hindi / Telugu

11. **I.D. CARDS:** ID cards will be issued to the students by June,2024 and they should wear the ID cards during School working days.
12. **SMS ALERTS:** Examination dates, Disciplinary remarks, Co-Curricular Activities, Absenteeism, Fee due reminders or any urgent information will be intimated through Mobile Alerts. Kindly inform the School office in writing if there is any change in your contact Mobile number and students have to enroll in the google classroom.
13. **SCHOOL FEE & TRANSPORT FEE:** School fee/Transport fee should be remitted as per the schedule. Fee defaulters may not be permitted to School or avail Transport. Cancellation of Transport or withdrawal from the school should be informed in writing one month in advance else the fee for the following month will be charged.
14. **PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEE / HOSTEL FEE:** Tuition Fee / Transport Fee should be paid online on / before 25th of April, August & December through school mobile app. Download "**J. SIKILE SCHOOL**" **Mobile App** from Google play store / Apple App store. Login details were already issued to all students and New Admissions will be given at the time of admission. For any queries regarding School App you can contact Mr. M. Anand Kumar, Computer Lab In-charge, Mobile – 9989048832. No cash payments will be accepted in the Accounts Office.
15. **SCHOOL TRANSPORT:** All safety norms and Transport rules as printed on the Transport Application must be adhered to when students avail the school Transport. Parents must make arrangements to drop and pick up their wards at the designated stops. Transport facility may be cancelled for perpetual misbehaviour and if a child/parent violates the rules.
16. **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA):** Every Saturday afternoon periods are allocated for CCA Activities: Yoga, Chess, Karate, Cookery, Dance, Art & Craft w.e.f. 29.06.2024.
17. **HOSTELS:** Disciplined and caring environment is created by a team of Wardens, Housekeepers, Resident Nurse and Catering staff. All resident students must abide by the rules. Resident facility may be cancelled for any breach of code of conduct and the Parents/Guardians should adhere to the visiting hours as per Hostel Rules. A child will be permitted to go home only through authorized guardians/parents.

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18. **PARENT TEACHER MEET:** Parents are encouraged to attend **Parent Teacher Meetings** to discuss their ward's progress and find solutions to academic or behavioural problems **TIME: 04:00 PM TO 05:30 PM.** The dates are printed in the Academic Calendar 2024-25.
19. **FIRST-AID:** FIRST-AID is administrated by the School Nurse and in case of emergency the student will be sent to Hospital/clinic based on the nature of sickness. Please inform in writing to the School Nurse of any pre-existing Medical condition of the students.
20. **PURIFIED DRINKING WATER:** OXYPLUS 500 LPH Reverse Osmosis based purification system provides purified drinking water to all the students.
21. **ELECTRONIC GADGETS** (mobiles, i-pod, play-stations, audio / video players, camera etc) are not permitted inside the school premises as per CBSE school rules. If found, the articles will be confiscated for 6 months.
